Proposal submitted for archeology study at Fort Harmony in location of west wall where Lee children may have died. Human remains continue to be found in archeology dig. Sinkhole 7 feet deep at well location. Well was 6 feet diameter and 100 feet deep. Possible hazard.

Lyman

Two prior digs by archeologists BYU. Last week found 39th china type. (People not as poor as thought by experts.) shards from China, Japan, England, Italy, France... Eastern U. S. etc. Nauvoo Temple commemorative plate piece found. Water source found. Four streams together. Rooms located on north and south side as well as east and west. Stair locations also found. 1854. West 20 North 20 South 20 East 10 tower in northwest corner. Wood flooring in southwest and northwest corners found. Human cranial (child) bones also found.
