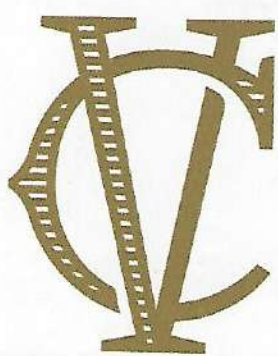

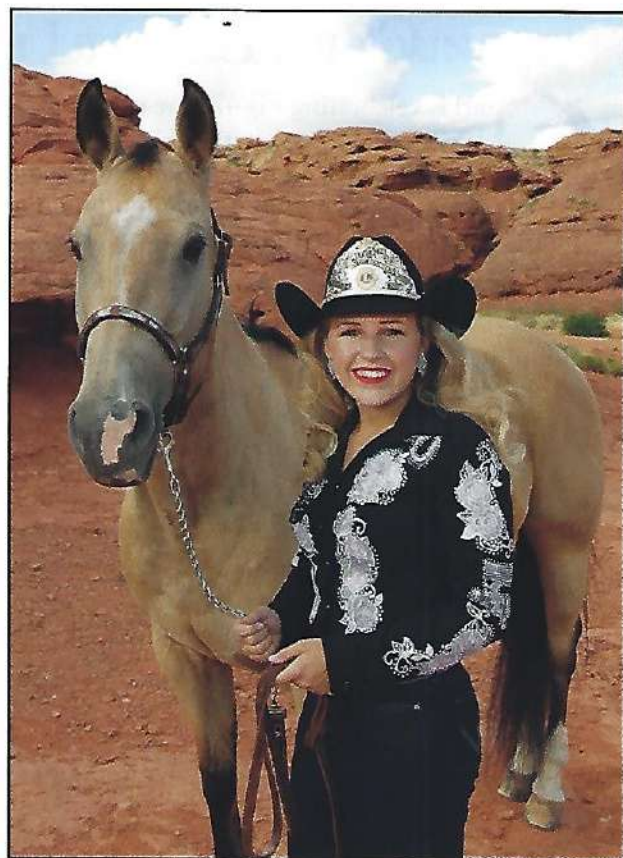

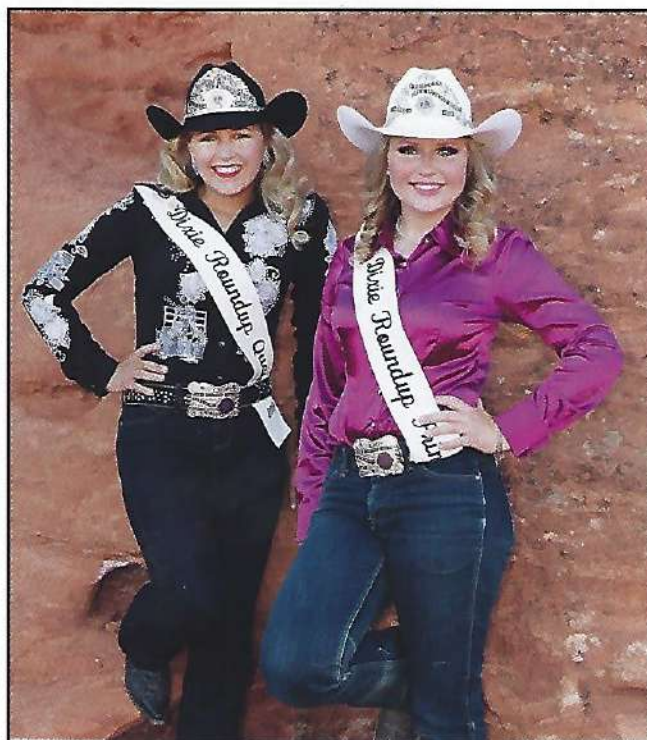
2019 Dixie Roundup Queen
