Guns: Sharpshooter and nationally recognized quick draw artist Gary Dixon will make an historical presentation on the popular guns of the west and the transition to cartridge firearms following the Civil War. It will cover military firearms, buffalo rifles, pistols, repeating rifles and shotguns that were used by lawmen, desperados and American Indians from the 1860s - 1890's. Numerous firearms of that period will be on display. He will also demonstrate his lightening quick draw and highlight Hollywood inaccuracies in portraying gunfights in movies.

Outlaws: Author Bill Betenson will talk about his new book, **Butch Cassidy, My Uncle**, followed by a book signing.
