The Virgin River will supply up to 85,000 acre-feet per year with the completion of Ash Creek and Warner Valley projects. The proposed Lake Powell Pipeline will deliver up to 86,000 acre-feet of water per year to Washington County. In the year 2060, demand for water is projected to be 198,000 acre-feet per year.
