The next DASIA field trip is next Thursday, July 27. It will be to Mt. Logan on the Arizona Strip. Mt. Logan is an area of interesting volcanic activity. It includes basalt ledges, cinder cones, ponderosa pine forests, pinyon-juniper woodlands, and a large, colorful, naturally eroded amphitheater known as Hells Hole. The area provides habitat for deer, turkey, and Kaibab squirrels. You can get information and/or make reservations at the Public Lands Information Center or call (435) 688-3200.
