GUIDED HURRICANE CANAL HIKES DURING PEACH DAYS

If you enjoy history and hiking, then please join us for one of the canal hikes going on during Peach Days this year on the morning of Saturday, Sept. 3!

There will be three hikes to choose from:

Easy hike: A stroll along the canal trail above Hurricane City led by "Canal Lady" Laura Thomas. This hike will meet at 6:55 a.m. at the canal monument at 200 N. 200 East. Hikers who choose this hike will be back in time for the Peach Days Parade.

Intermediate hike: A hike along part of the canal in the canyon as well as an ascent to Panorama Point along the Hurricane Hill Trail. Led by Dr. Greg Last, this hike will be just over four miles. If interested in this hike, meet at 6:30 a.m. at the main monument in the middle of the Hurricane Valley Heritage Park at the Southwest Corner of State and Main.

Strenuous hike: This hike follows most of the canal's course through the canyon and goes through tunnels and crosses flumes and one big pipe. It is approximately 5.7 miles long and led by Reuben Wadsworth. Those wanting to hike this route will also meet at 6:30 a.m. at the main monument in the middle of the Hurricane Valley Heritage Park at the Southwest Corner of State and Main.
