on a round trip rate." Our sister Mary Alice agrees to accompany me, from here, conditioned you can inform us of a way to go, comfortable from Modena to Pine Valley and return. I fear it will be too warm to reach St. George, otherwise I would like to see people there. It is my intention to leave here on Saturday 21st inst, at 4:45 P.M. and go to American Fork and spend Sunday, at frequenting Bishop John Hinckley, whose mother is now absent to the Isle of Man. It is my intention to get back Sunday night, or Monday morning, in time to take train at 4:45, with my sister Mary Alice, for Modena, where we expect to arrive on 24th. I trust this will find you and each of yours well as it leaves me. Accept my love to you and each of yours and ours. I am your true and affectionate Brother, Wm. M. Cannon
