

C. M. FLECKINGER

C. M. Fleckinger was a pioneer oil man, being born in the Penna Oil field district, and has followed this occupation all of his life. He was born in Meadville, Pennsylvania, October 27, 1884, a son of Mr. and Mrs. W. H. Fleckinger, and was 50 years old at the time of his death. His father was a pioneer oil man in Pennsylvania.

Mr. Fleckinger came here from Long Beach, California, where he had been in business for seven years. He first came to this district about three years ago when he was employed in the Virgin Oil fields.

Mr. Fleckinger was a Mason, belonging to the Blue Lodge in Bridgeport, Texas; the Scottish rite in Yorksborrow, Texas, and the Shrine in Ft. Worth, Texas.

He is survived by his widow Margaret M. Fleckinger, who is now in Virgin, Utah.

Mr. Fleckinger was in the employment of the Arrowhead Petroleum company, supervising the shooting of the well at the time of the disaster.
