

Marguretta “Maggie” Rymer Mann Hassell

Marguretta “Maggie” Rymer was born 27 May 1858 in Brighton, Sussex, England.¹ She was the daughter of Maggie Rymer. She immigrated to America in the 1870s and married Henry J Mann in 1879 in Silver Reef, Washington, Utah Territory.² Henry was an engineer in Silver Reef on the 1880 census.³

Maggie married Louis Hassell in 1885 in Silver Reef.⁴ It is not known what happened to her first marriage (or to Henry after 1880). She and Louis are living in Mammoth Precinct, Juab, Utah, on the 1900 census. It indicates that she is the mother of three children, two still living, but it is unknown when or where they were born or who the fathers were.⁵ Marguretta died 3 December 1905 in Spanish Fork, Utah, Utah after a month of bronchitis due to asthma. She was buried in the Evergreen Cemetery.⁶

Louis remarried and lived in Springville until he was hospitalized with nephritis. He died 10 April 1930 in the Utah County Infirmary in Provo and was buried in the Springville Cemetery.⁷
