MINNIE BURGESS INDIAN CHILDREN OF SOUTHERN UTAH

*MINNIE BURGESS was a Lamanite who came to live with the family of MELANCTHON and MARGARET BURGESS (599) in 1862. It was about the time of the "Big Flood" which greeted the Pioneers soon after their arrival in St. George, that a brother of Jacob Hamblin came to the home of Melancthon W. And Margaret J. McIntire Burgess, his wife, and asked them to buy a little Indian girl. Sister Burgess had no girls in her family at that time and was so anxious for one, that she begged her husband to buy the little Indian girl. He consented, and they paid Mr. Hamblin \$50. In provisions and cash for her. She was about five years old, as near as could be judged, and Sister Burgess named her Minnie Viroca. She was taken into the home and raised as their own. She was adopted 16 July 1890. She was sent to school where she learned to read and write. No difference was ever made in the children. As a child, she played with neighbor children. Among them were A. W. Ivins, Jed, Jacob and Frank Gates and others. One of their main sports was shooting the bow and arrow. The boys were much chagrined because Minnie could always outclass them, showing the Indian skill at that sport. She grew up to be an ideal housekeeper. She married ALBERT HARTMAN of Leeds, who was born about 1853 in Utah. She was the mother of four children. She died at the birth of the fourth one in 1897. One daughter, Mrs. William Nichols, still lives in Leeds, Utah.
