

Basic Information

Operational Hours:

Open May 1 to November 30. Dates vary depending on weather conditions.

Check-in: 3:00pm; **Check-out:** 11:00am.

Important: Have your 4-digit door combination with you! It is contained in your e-mail confirmation from www.recreation.gov

Cabins: There are 7 cabins. Each cabin sleeps 4 people in 1 full bed and 2 twin-sized beds. Small wood stove, chairs, and dresser included. Electric outlets. No bathrooms in cabins.

Other Amenities: Picnic tables, handicap accessible bathrooms (2 shower stalls and 2 toilets for each gender), drinking water, community kitchen, dining area, outdoor fire pit, gas BBQ grill, limited parking (no RV's please).

Important: No firewood provided. Firewood can be bought in Fredonia and Jacob Lake, AZ.

Reservations: Search on "Big Springs Cabin Site" at www.recreation.gov

Fees: \$65.00 per night per cabin. Seven cabins.

Cell Phone-Internet Service: There is no cell signal or internet access at this location.



How to Get Here

From Jacob Lake, AZ:

From AZ Hwy 67 just south of Jacob Lake, head west on FS 461 for 5.3 miles to FS 462. Continue west on FS 462 (right) for 3.1 miles to FS 22. Turn south (left) at FS 22 and continue 6.6 miles until you see the Big Springs Cabins on your left. Total trip distance is about 15.0 miles.

From Fredonia, AZ:

Just 1.2 miles south of Fredonia on US 89A turn onto FS 22. Stay on FS 22 for 27.3 miles until you see the Big Springs Cabins on your left. Pavement on FS 22 ends after 20.7 miles. Look for this sign below. Total trip distance is about 28.5 miles.

From North Rim Lodge at Grand Canyon National Park:

Head north from lodge to main gate on Hwy 67. Proceed straight from gate toward Jacob Lake for 4 miles. Turn West (left) on FS 22 for 23 miles. Watch for signs. Cabins will be on the right. Total trip distance is about 37 miles.

Please close cattle gate upon entering or leaving cabin site. Thank you.

Big Springs Cabins

The Big Springs Cabin Site is located approximately 28 miles (~45 minutes) from Fredonia, Ariz., on Forest Service Road 22, and 45 miles (1 hour drive) to the Grand Canyon North Rim.

The cabins are a perfect base camp for day hikes on the Kaibab Plateau, or for group retreats in the cool pines.

Visitors can enjoy picnicking, sight-seeing, wildlife viewing and access to scenic overlooks of the Grand Canyon from within the forest.

Interior Amenities

Community Kitchen:

The kitchen is equipped with the following:

- Dishes, glassware, flatware, cookware, utensils
- Toaster, coffeemakers, griddle, blenders, crockpots, mixer
- Three full-size refrigerator/freezers, 2 full-size stoves with ovens, 2 microwave ovens



Community Living/Meeting Room:

The living room is equipped with the following:

- Tables/chairs seat up to 36
- Comfortable furniture in living room (5 recliners)
- TV w/DVD player; DVDs, games, puzzles, cards
- Area information and maps



Interior Amenities

Cabin Rooms:

Each cabin is equipped with the following:

- One full-sized bed and two twin beds. **Note:** Bring your own towels, bedsheets, pillows, linens, or sleeping bags.
- One small wood-burning stove. **Note:** This is the only way to heat the cabin. Guests may bring small electric heater
- Chairs, dresser, and closet
- Electrical outlets and room lights

Other Important Notes

- There are **no laundry machines** for public use.
- **No pets permitted**, except service animals.
- No firewood provided.
- **This is an active Forest Service Admin Site:** Personnel live/work in the north half of the complex. Please stay out of their work area.
