Oct. 8 Main event: Keynote Speaker – Terry Tempest Williams who launched her new book: *EROSIONS: Essays in Undoing*
Held at the Zion Room at DSU – with seating capacity of **250 – no seats were empty.**

The evening included: a Poetry to Art Competition – organized by Carroll Shreeve Riley with 18 competitors.

Oct. 9, 10, 11, Wed. Thurs. & Fri. evenings Workshops were held with writers and authors at various locations in the city.

Sat. Oct. 12. Beginning with a Keynote speaker, Chris Phillips, internationally known author, workshops followed all day – topics included: Non-Fiction & Memoire, Fiction & Scriptwriting, Publication & Marketing, Poetry & Poets – with **91 attendees.**

Twelve children's events took place in Libraries in the City and County – during the Festival – it as estimated that 1,500 students were participants in reading and story telling.
