ARARA 2012 Conference Field Trips: General Information and Instructions

The 2012 ARARA Conference offers a varied selection of field trips to view many of the fascinating rock art sites in southeastern

Utah and surrounding areas. Access to most of the sites is easy to moderate. Vehicles with high clearance will work best on the dirt

roads. Car pooling will be a necessity. Weather may be “iffy,” so plan on layers, rain gear, and good sturdy shoes, and remember your

hat, sunscreen, and camera. Walking sticks may be helpful. *Participants are responsible for bringing along plenty of water* to ensure

healthy hydration. Lunches for day trips will be up to the individual. Registered conference attendees will have a strong possibility

of both Monday and Friday field trips.

1. Santa Clara River and Anasazi Ridge Petroglyphs. 7:30 am to 4:00 pm. Limit 15. Any vehicle. Easy to moderate.

2. Zion National Park and Quail Creek. 7:30 am to 4:00 pm. Limit 12. Any vehicle. Moderate walking.

3. Gunlock Reservoir and Nearby Sites. 7:30 am to 4:00 pm. Limit 15. Any vehicle; high-clearance advantageous.

4. Fort Pierce Wash. 7:30 am to 4:00 pm. Limit 15. 4WD high-clearance vehicle required, moderately strenuous hike.

5. Little Creek Mesa. 7:30 am to 4:00 pm. Limit 15. High-clearance vehicle required, moderately easy hike.

6. Browse and Peter's Leap. 7:30 am to 4:00 pm. Limit 15. High-clearance vehicle required. Moderate to strenuous.

7. Snow Canyon East, Lion's Mouth, and Black Point. 7:30 am to 4:00 pm. Limit 15. Any vehicle, high clearance preferable, easy to moderately strenuous hiking.

8. Quail Creek and Babylon. 7:30 am to 2:00 pm. Limit 15. High-clearance recommended, drive-ups or moderately easy.

9. Little Black Mountain, Serenity Hills, and Bear Site. 7:30 am to 1:00 pm. Limit 15. High-clearance required, drive-ups or short walks.

10. Parowan Gap to Black Point Loop. 7:30 am to 4:00 pm. Limit 15. High-clearance recommended. Easy to moderately strenuous plus drive-up.

11. Whitney-Hartman and the Sheep Panel. 7:00 am to 3:00 pm. Limit 12 persons and three vehicles by BLM regulation. High-clearance required, moderately strenuous hiking.

- 12. South Fork of Indian Creek and Rosie Canyon.** 7:30 am to 4:30 pm. Limit 15. 4WD high-clearance mandatory, moderate hiking.
- 13. Nampawep and Paiute Cave.** 7:30 am to 5:30 pm. Limit 15. Any vehicle, two-hour hike, moderate.
- 14. Mt. Irish.** 7:30 am to 5:30 pm. Limit 15. High-clearance required, moderately easy walking.
- 15. Anasazi Ridge.** 8:00 am to Noon. Limit 15. Any vehicle. Moderately easy, ADA-accessible.

- 16. Santa Clara and Anasazi Ridge, same as Trip No. 1.** 7:30 am to 4:00 pm. Limit 15.
- 17. Zion National Park and Quail Creek, same as Trip No. 2.** 7:30 am to 4:00 pm. Limit 12.
- 18. Gunlock Reservoir and Nearby Sites, same as Trip No. 3.** 7:30 am to 4:00 pm. Limit 15.
- 19. Fort Pierce Wash, same as Trip No. 4.** 7:30 am to 4:00 pm. Limit 15
- 20. Red Cliffs, Babylon, and Quail Creek.** 7:30 am to 4:00 pm. Limit 15. High-clearance required. Drive-up plus moderate walk.
- 21. Canaan Gap, Yellow Man, Cave Valley.** 7:30 am to 4:00 pm. Limit 12. Light climbing, 1-mile walk in sandy soil..
- 22. Virgin River Gorge, Little Black Mountain, and the Bear Site.** 7:30 am to 3:00 pm. Limit 15. High-clearance recommended, moderately strenuous plus drive-up with easy walking.
- 23. Rosie Slots and Rosie Canyon Petroglyphs.** 7:30 am to 4:00 pm. Limit 15. Easy to moderate.
- 24. Lion's Mouth, Black Point, and Parowan Gap.** 7:30 am to 3:00 pm. Limit 15. High-clearance recommended, moderate hiking plus a drive-up.
- 25. Parowan Gap to Black Point Loop, same as Trip No. 10.** 7:30 am to 4:00 pm. Limit 15.
- 26. Kirk's Grotto and Babe's Butte.** 7:00 am to 3:00 pm. Limit 12 people and three vehicles at the trailhead by BLM regulation. Highclearance required, moderate steep hike.
- 27. Nampawep and Paiute Cave, same as Trip No. 13.** 7:30 am to 5:30 pm. Limit 15.
- 28. Snake Gulch.** 7:00 am to 7:00 pm. Limit 15. Strenuous. High-clearance recommended, 10-mile roundtrip hike.
- 29. White River Narrows.** 7:30 am to 6:30 pm. Limit 15. High-clearance recommended, drive-ups and easy walks.
- 30. Quail Creek and Cave Valley.** 8:00 am to 1:00 pm. Limit 12. Any vehicle, drive-ups and moderate walk.
