

## Prominent Archaeologist Returns to Silver Reef

During May the public will once again have the opportunity to be informed and entertained by one of the foremost scholars of the history of the ghost mining town of Silver Reef. The Museum at Silver Reef is pleased to host a return visit from Dr. Robert L. Schuyler, Ph.D., Associate Professor of anthropology at the University of Pennsylvania. Dr. Schuyler has studied the archaeological history of the mining town of Silver Reef since 1980, making numerous working visits to Southern Utah. Over the course of his stay this month, he will present three lectures and lead two walking tours during which he will describe his excavation of sites in old Silver Reef, discuss his findings and present fascinating glimpses into the history of what was once the largest town in Washington County.

The public is cordially invited to attend these free events. The lectures will be presented at 10 a.m. on two Saturdays, May 10 and 17; and at 5 p.m. on Friday, May 16. The walking tours will be at 8:30 a.m. on Saturday, May 10 and 17. All events will be held at the old Cosmopolitan restaurant, adjacent to the Museum, 1903 Wells Fargo Rd., Leeds.
