The Saint George Basin is home to a spectacular concentration of Native American Petroglyphs and Pictographs, clues to the thoughts and beliefs of earlier inhabitants. David Lee and his colleagues have been documenting these images throughout the last six years. For the last ten years, Mr. Lee has also been documenting rock art and associated traditional knowledge in Northern Australia. The overwhelming majority of refutes earlier hypothesis, and shows that rather than being monolithic expressions of hunters or healers, rock art produced by forager societies can be seen as playing an important role in the lives of everyone in the group, and in linking that group to specific places.
