

Historical Society Field Trip

The Washington County Historical Society is sponsoring its first field trip of the year on Saturday, January 21. The trip will be a driving tour of Long Valley, an area south and west of the Southern Parkway, which contains many evidences of man's use from pre-historic through pioneer times. Field trip participants will visit and learn about such sites as pioneer dams on the Virgin River, pre-historic native sites and geological points of interest. A little hiking at individual stops may be required.

There is no cost for the field trip and the public is invited. Participants should meet in the parking lot of the St. George BLM office (345 E. Riverside Dr.) at 10 a.m. on the 21st. Carpools will be arranged from there.
