Former tribal Chairperson of the Paiute Indian Tribe of Utah, Lora Tom, will present “Together Towards Tomorrow” on Friday, September 15 at 7:30 pm in the Canyon Community Center in Springdale, 126 Lion Boulevard. Lora’s talk will focus on leadership, partnership, growth, and support of building future tribal development and new beginnings together—the challenge of tribal governance in the 21st century.

Lora Tom has worked with the Paiute Indian Tribe of Utah for 24 years, has been in tribal leadership for 19 years, and served as its chairperson for 8 years. She currently serves as vice-chairman to the Cedar band of Southern Paiutes. She serves as the Deputy Health Director for the Health Department, and also currently serves as a member of the Cedar City Hospital board of trustees.
