In keeping with the spirit of Pioneer Day celebrations, two of the best story tellers in the region will swap lies and other tall tales about life on the Arizona Strip.

After a long career with Utah Power & Light, Milt returned to his roots of river rafting and climbing on public lands in the west. He hired on with the National Park Service as an Interpretive Ranger at the Kolob Canyons section of Zion National Park, followed by a stint of collecting oral histories for Grand Canyon Parashant National Monument. He now works with DASIA, with the primary role of arranging scintillating lectures and leading adventures across public lands.

An experienced archeologist and ethno-botanist, Greg has over 20 years of river and hiking guiding experience in fragile desert areas of the Colorado Plateau and "specializes" in the Arizona Strip. He currently works as an archeologist for Grand Canyon Parasahnt National Monument.
