Pipe Spring National Monument will be leading a hike into Mu'uputs Canyon on March 29th, 2020

The Mu'uputs Canyon hike is a moderate 2-mile round trip that focuses on the history and lifeways of the Kaibab Paiute Indians. Participants will also visit two fascinating petroglyph sites.

Hikes will be limited to 20 visitors; please call Pipe Spring National Monument to make reservations (928-643-7105). There will be a \$10 per-person tribal fee for this hike. We hope to see you on the trail!

Pipe Spring National Monument is located 15 miles west of Fredonia, Arizona on Arizona highway 389 and 45 miles east of Hurricane, Utah on Utah highway 59 and Arizona highway 389.

The hike will meet behind the Visitor Center. Please come prepared to spend time in cold desert conditions. Bring water and layers. The terrain is sandy and rocky.
