



Ranger Reub Hikes Along the Hurricane Canal

Saturday, September 4, 2021

Join me for a guided, historical hike along the route of the old Hurricane Canal this Saturday, September 4! We will be meeting at the statue in the middle of the Hurricane Valley Heritage Park at 6:25 a.m. (SW corner of State and Main in Hurricane, Utah).

There are actually three hikes to choose from:

A longer, strenuous option (approximately 5.7 miles) along most of the canal's route in the canyon that goes through tunnels and flumes. This is the one I will lead.

A shorter hike (approximately 4.6 miles) that traverses some of the canal in the canyon as well as some of the Hurricane Hill Trail. This is led by Dr. Greg Last.

A short hike (0.5 mile) that leads along the canal above town led by Dan Zaleski. This one meets at the canal monument at 200 E. 200 North (very east end of 200 North) and departs at 7 a.m.

Historical Hurricane Canal T-shirts (proof picture in comments) will be available for purchase for \$8. Also, if you don't feel up to hiking and would like to help, we are in need of at least one more shuttle driver for the long hike, which would consist of transporting hikers in a truck or other high-clearance vehicle to the Virgin Dam Trailhead (hikers will leave their cars at the Hurricane Hill Trailhead, where the hike ends).
