9 to 11 am

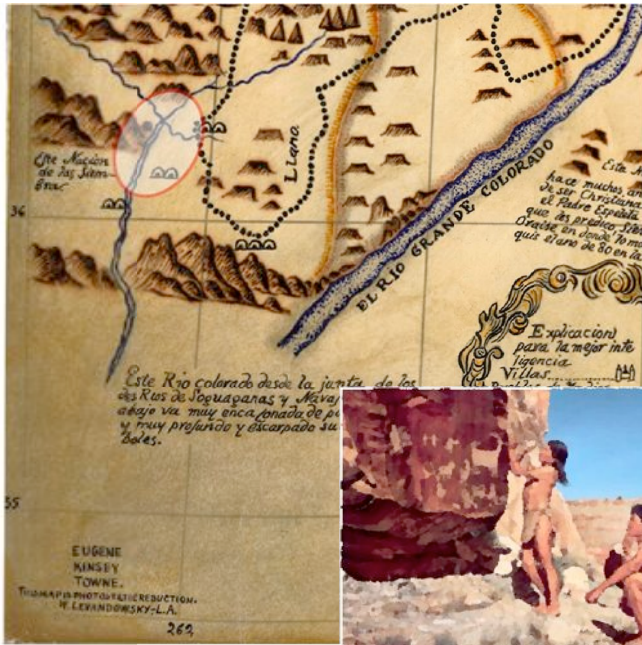
We will go inside the Wallace Blake Farmhouse which was placed on the National Register in 1978.

See the foundation of the Bloomington Schoolhouse and the still standing remains of the Ern Larson home and granary.

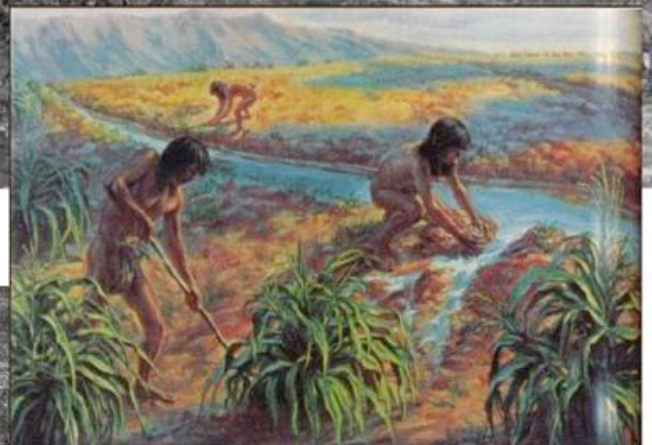
Go to Bloomington's Petroglyph Park .
