

# Plans For Work Program Outlined At Dixie Jr. College

leges have been cut one-third, according to Mr. Frischnecht. Dixie college allotment is set at \$1500, President Smith reports. There is a small possibility that the allotments might be increased if an "emergency" arises, it is stated in word received by Mr. Frischnecht, but he thinks this is not likely.

Mr. Frischnecht reported a summary of a survey made during the summer as to student reaction to the program in Utah. The results of this survey will do much to improve the administration of the program this year.
