

# Forty Boys And Ten Girls To Be Registered Under N.Y.A.

Forty boys and 10 girls will be permitted to take advantage of the N.Y.A. program in Washington county for the coming year which is under the direction of Von Cottam.

The boys and girls will attend school for a half day where they will be given vocational training under the supervision of the Dixie junior college. The boys will live in a dormitory at the Julia Foster residence and the girls will be housed at Miner Prisbrey's. Mrs. Dan Seegmiller will supervise the boys' cooking and home activities.

In explaining the program, Mr. Cottam states that the big objective of the program is to give the students training in vocation that they are most interested in. This will consist of the half day in school and the work on the

various projects such as the sidewalk which they are now working on. Projects may be suggested by civic organizations and they will be added as needed.

Students will be given enough work to make \$30 a month. Out of this sum they must pay their board, which will be \$18 for the girls and perhaps a little higher for the boys. Students on this program must keep up to a standard in their studies and are expected to take an interest in their work and produce a satisfactory amount.

Washington county students will be given first choice but if there are not enough in the county to fill the positions, students from adjoining counties will be considered. Those interested in this project may secure additional data from Mr. Cottam.
