

NYA Project To Improve Rodeo Stands and Fences

**Thirteen Eligible Youths
To Get Two-Months'
Work From This Program**

Word was received today that an NYA project sponsored by the St. George City corporation and signed by Mayor D. C. Watson had just been approved calling for extensive improvements of rodeo corrals and building of a judging stand at the City Park rodeo grounds. The National Youth administration has allocated \$616 in Federal funds for youth labor and supervision on the project at St. George and the city has appropriated \$162 for equipment, materials and supplies. The St. George Lions club is also co-sponsor.

Work for the NYA youth will consist of building 397 running feet of 6-foot fence, setting posts and building a judges' stand, then painting the corrals and stand. Thirteen eligible youths from St. George and vicinity will get two months' work on the project at eighty hours per month or 2,080 man-hours in all.

The NYA project will add greatly to rodeo facilities in Utah's Dixie and it is hoped that in the future the improved facilities will help in attracting some of the West's top-hands to the rodeos.
