NOTICE OF ASSESSMENT

You are hereby notified that the State Tax Commission has assessed as of January 1, 1949, for taxation purposes, the property listed and described in the attached schedules, in the amounts indicated.

If you are dissatisfied with the assessment, you may file a protest which will be considered by the Commission at its office, 104 State Capitol, Salt Lake City, Utah, during the period May 16 to June 13, 1949. Such protests may be presented in writing, or if you prefer, you may arrange with the Secretary for a hearing before the Commission.

The week commencing May 16 has been set aside for considering objections which may be raised to the assessments on mines, while the week commencing May 23 has been designated for hearing objections to public utility assessments.

Written protests will receive the same careful consideration that will be accorded the objections made by the taxpayers who appear personally, but it will be advisable to send such protests as early as possible in order that there will be sufficient time for us to write for further information if necessary.

The time for considering any objections to assessments fixed by the Tax Commission this year ends on June 13.
