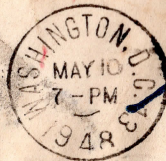

This is in reply to your letters of May 4th and 5th.




