Your petition on behalf of Thomas  
Ernest Burr, Don Burgess, Law, W. Burgess  
Jr., Harrison Burgess, Eli Whipple  
Lorinda Brown, Vanessa Bryce, Stu  
Howley and George Howley, respectfully  
ask your honorable body to grant to the  
before named persons the right to  
use a portion of the water of the Santa Clara  
for irrigating purposes in Pine Valley.

The before named will hold them-  
selves subject to the legislation of  
your honorable body and to the direction  
of such Water Masters as you may  
appoint. And as is duty bound  
your petitioners will say may.

" A petition was read from Robert Gardner on behalf of himself, Ernest Snow, Wm. J. Snow, Wm. Burgess, John Harrison, Thomas Whipple, Edward Brown, Ebenezer Bryce, John Hawley, and George Hawley, praying for a grant of water from the Santa Clara to be used for irrigating purposes in Pine Valley."

" Moved that the Santa Clara Water Master be instructed to authorize the taking out of the Santa Clara in Pine Valley for irrigating purposes by the persons named in the before named petition until otherwise instructed, and that said Water Master appoint Walter Master for Pine Valley - seconded by Alderman Emory - Carried -"
