Order,

The following
is a resolution introduced by Mr
Fitch and adopted by the Convention
at its closing sitting for taking
the Census of this Territory.

"Resolved that the Probate
Judges and Selectmen of each County
are requested to divide their respec-
tive Counties into districts, appoint
Census takers thereon, and provide
for taking a Census of the number of
inhabitants. The duties of such
Census takers to commence on the
third Monday of March 1872, and
terminate within one week thereafter.

The said Returns to be certified
under oath to the County Clerks of
their respective Counties, and
by said Clerks forthwith trans-
mitted to R. L. Campbell the Sec-
retary of this Convention; said Secretary
to open and compile the same, and
to forward a copy thereof duly certified,
to H. A. H. Cooper, Delegate to Congress
from Utah Territory." In

Compliance with the foregoing resolution
of the Court when, the County Court for
this County, at its regular March
Term Session, held Monday the 6th
instant, divided the County into
three Census districts, Middle, ^{St George}
and Santa Clara Settlements,
being district number One, and
appointed yourself Census taker
in said district; this being your
official notification of your
said appointment.

You will please
be in readiness to commence
taking the Census in said District
number One at the time specified
in said Resolution, and make returns
in conformity to the same.
