

Special Meeting of the
City Council, held at
Grand Central Hall,
June 18th 1891.

" After much discussion in relation
to the Short Supply of Water from the
Santa Clara and the probable causes
of the same, it was

Moved by Councillor Carter,
Seconded by Alderman Bentley,
that Miss M. Sanders be and he
is hereby appointed General
Water Master of the entire
Stream of the Santa Clara River.
Carried -

Moved by Alderman
Bentley, Seconded by Councillor Carter,
that the General Water Master
of the Santa Clara River, is hereby
ordered to examine the Santa Clara
River from its mouth to its source,
and find out if any person or persons
are taking out and using the waters
of the Santa Clara River, without a
grant from the City Council, or right
granted by the General Water Master
of said waters; and if he finds that
the waters of the Santa Clara are being
illegally used as aforesaid, he is
hereby authorized to go forth with

Stop the use of said water.

And further, that he is hereby
authorized to stop the use of the
waters of the Santa Clara given by
permission of the City Council
September 10th 1886 temporarily
to the following named persons,
to wit; Robert Gardner, Crocker & Co.,
Wm Burgess & Co., Wm Burgess & Co. jr
Harrison Burgess, Eli Whipple,
Louis Brown, Ebenzer Bryce,
Wm Hawley and George Hawley;
Such permission being forthwith
hereby discontinued and withdrawn.

And the said General Water
Master of the Santa Clara River,
E. M. Sanders is hereby authorized
to proceed according to law,
against all persons failing to
comply with his regulations - Carried
