

Boating Accident

PERTH, Scotland. UP — Two American airmen and two Scotsmen drowned in a boating accident last night on the Lake of Menteith. They were in a party of six in a dinghy which capsized some distance from the shore. The other two, Americans, reached shore safely.

The drowned Americans were tentatively identified as Bill Davenport, believed to be 20 and a resident of New York, and Gene Asche. U. S. Air Force officials withheld identifications until next of kin are notified. The body of one American was recovered today. The missing Scotsmen were Ian Cameron, 36, custodian of an island in the middle of the lake, and David Drummond, 59, caretaker of a children's holiday camp.
