

# **OBITUARY OF LEMUEL GLEN LEAVITT**

January 23, 1905 - November 4, 1993

Lemuel Glen Leavitt, 88, died Thursday, November 4, 1993 at his home.

A retired rancher and heavy equipment operator, he was born in Gunlock, Utah, January 23, 1905 to Lemuel S. and Susan Burgess Leavitt. He married Florence McArthur December 30, 1930 in the St. George LDS Temple.

Among many years of Church service, he served as the last bishop of South Ward and the first bishop of the Second Ward in St. George and as a bishop's counselor in Veyo.
