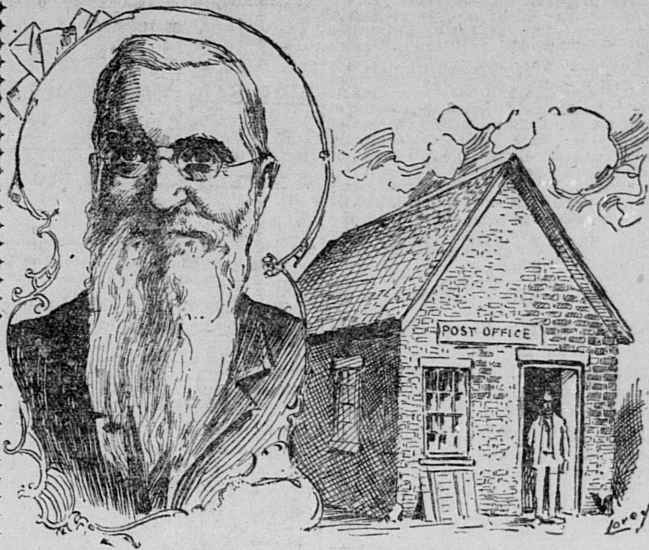


UTAH'S OLDEST POSTMASTER.



The above is a picture of Utah's oldest postmaster and the oldest postoffice in the state.* The former is John Pymm, and the latter is his postoffice at St. George. Mr. Pymm is 84 years of age, hale and hearty and a simon-pure

Democrat. He was appointed postmaster at St. George in 1861, and has filled the position ever since, being the present incumbent. The postoffice was built in 1862, and was the first building erected in the state for that purpose.
