1824, Feb 29 – Mary Adelia is born to Edmund Zebulon Carbine and Adelia Rider in Cairo, Greene Co., New York .

1827, Jan 22 – Mary's brother Edmund Zebulon Carbine is born in Cairo, Greene Co., New York.

1828, Oct 29 – Mary's sister Elmira Dorcas Eugenia Carbine is born in Cairo, Greene Co., New York.

1830 – In the 1830 census living in Cairo, Greene Co., New York listed as a female 5 thru 9.

1832, Nov 23 – Mary's sister Julia Aner Carbine is born in Cairo, Greene Co., New York.

1835, Feb 17 – Mary's brother William Van Orden Carbine is born in Cairo, Greene Co., New York.

1840 – In the 1840 census living in Southern, Greene Co., New York listed as a female 15 thru 19. 1

1842, Jan 1 – Mary's mother Adelia Rider Carbine joined the Mormon Church being the first to receive the Gospel in Orange County.

1843 – The Carbine family moves to Nauvoo.

1844, May 2 – Marriage to Amos Northrop in Nauvoo, Hancock Co., Illinois.

1845 – Birth of daughter Eugenia Dorleski Northrop in Nauvoo, Hancock Co., Illinois.

1846, Aug 30 – Death of Mary's father Edmund Zebulon Carbine in Camp Creek, Hancock Co., Illinois.

1846, Dec 25 – Death of husband Amos Northrop in Winter Quarters, Douglas Co., Nebraska.

1848, Jun 5 – Mary's brother William Van Orden Carbine leaves Winter Quarters, Douglas Co., Nebraska with the Brigham Young Company.

1848, Aug 30 – Marriage to Robert Cowan Petty in Winter Quarters, Douglas Co., Nebraska. Some say they were married in the spring of 1849 in Council Point, Iowa.

1850, Jan – Birth of son Llewellyn Petty in Winter Quarters, Douglas Co., Nebraska

1850, Jun 7 – Left from Kanesville to Great Salt Lake Valley at 1:00 P.M. for Bethlehem. Rode ten miles and camped at Margaret's Creek, a very beautiful shady spot. We heard the wolves howl in the night for the first time. Our horses were frightened.

1850, Jul 18 – Death of son Llewellyn Petty

1850, Oct. 14 – Under the direction of Apostle Wilford Woodruff, Captain of the Eighth Company about 209 individuals and about 44 wagons arrived in the Great Salt Lake Valley.

1851, Jun 17 – Death of sister Elmira Dorcas Eugenia Carbine.

1851, Sep 14 – Birth of daughter Mary Adelia Petty in Holliday, Salt Lake Co., Utah.

1853, Jul 23 – Marriage of sister Julia Aner Carbine to William Warren Taylor.

1854, Apr 26 – Birth of daughter Eleanor Roberta Petty at Fort Herriman, Salt Lake Co., Utah

1856, Feb 2 – Death of husband Robert Cowan Petty in Spavinaw, Mayes Co., Oklahoma

1856 – Found in the Utah Census as a resident of Davis Co., Utah.

1857, Apr 18 – Death of brother Edmund Zebulon Carbine in New York City, New York Co., New York.

1857, Dec 17 – Marriage to George Robert Grant in Kaysville, Davis Co., Utah.

1858, Sep 11 – Birth of son Edmund Carbine Grant in Kaysville, Davis Co., Utah.

1860, Apr 4 – Death of daughter Eugenia Dorleski Northrop in Slaterville, Weber Co., Utah drowning.

1860, Jun 25 – Listed in the

1860 Census for Kaysville, Davis Co., Utah as Mary A. Grant. Children living in home are Mary A., Ellen and Ed.

1860, Jul 10 – Birth of daughter Julia Francesca Grant in Kaysville, Davis Co., Utah.

1860, Aug 30 – Daughter Mary Adelia Pettie baptized by Samuel Henderson in the Kaysville Ward known as the North Cottonwood Ward at the time.

1860, Sep 16 – Mary Adelia Carbine Pettie confirmed by William Payne.

1860, Oct 10 – Son Edmund Carbine Grant blessed in the North Cottonwood Ward (Kaysville)

1860, Oct 20 – Daughter Julia Francesca Grant blessed in the North Cottonwood by Rosel Hyde.

1861, Feb 25 – Mary's brother William Van Orden Carbine marries Susan Hulda Miller.

1861, Oct 18 – Julia Francesca Grant is scalded to death and dies in Kaysville, Davis Co., Utah.

1862, May 17 – Mary Adelia Carbine marries to William Warren Taylor in Harrisville, Weber Co., Utah.

1863, Feb 9 – Birth of son Albert Eugene Taylor in Harrisburg, Kane Co., Utah.

1865, Apr 6 – Birth of son Francis Green Taylor in Harmony, Kane Co., Utah.

1867, Apr 28 – Birth of son James Edgar Taylor in Harmony, Kane Co., Utah.

1867, May 26 – Sister-in-law Susan Hulda Miller Carbine dies.

1870, May 30 – Brother William Van Orden Carbine marries second to Sarah Jane Miller.

1870, Jul 16 – Listed in the 1870 Census for Harmony, Kane Co., Utah Mary A. Taylor. Children at home are Eleanor, Mary A., Edmond, Albert, William and James.

1872, Nov 28 – Daughter Eleanor Roberta Petty marries Joseph Winkle Sawyer.

1873, Oct 22 – Granddaughter Mary Roberta Sawyer is born in New Harmony, Washington Co., Utah.

1873, Dec 25 – Daughter Mary Adelia Petty marries Benjamin John Homer in Clarkston, Cache Co., Utah.

1875, Jun 25 – Grandson William Harrison Homer is born in Swan Lake, Oneida Co., Idaho.

1876, Mar 25 – Granddaughter Adelia Francesca Sawyer is born in New Harmony, Washington Co., Utah.

1876, Dec 7 – Grandson Benjamin Petty Homer is born in Clarkston, Cache Co., Utah.

1878, Feb 19 – Grandson John Albert Homer is born in Clarkston, Cache Co., Utah.

1878, Jul 20 – Granddaughter Eugenia Dorleski Sawyer is born in Cedar City, Iron Co., Utah

1878, Sep 24 - Appointed Postmistress of New Harmony, Kane Co., by the Postmaster General of the United States and served for 25 years.

1879, Nov 30 – Granddaughter Mary Adelia Homer is born in Clarkston, Cache Co., Utah.

1880, Jan 28 – Granddaughter Mary Adelia Homer dies in Clarkston and is buried in the Clarkston Cemetery in Cache Co., Utah.

1880, Jun 2 – Listed in the 1880 Census for Harmony, Kane Co., Utah as Mary A. Taylor. Children at home are Edmund, Albert, Francis and James and granddaughter Mary Roberta Sawyer.

1881, Jan 23 – Granddaughter Nellie Maud Homer is born in Trenton, Cache Co., Utah.

1882, Jan 1 – Granddaughter Ernestine Leslie Hamilton is born in New Harmony, Washington Co., Utah.

1882, Oct 6 – Grandson Russell King Homer is born in Clarkston, Cache Co., Utah.

1884, Jun 7 – Granddaughter Eleanor E. Homer is born in Clarkston, Cache Co., Utah.

1885, Feb 4 – Son Edmund Carbine Grant marries Emily Jane Adair in Nutrioso, Apache Co., Arizona.

1885, Nov 21 – Grandson Edmund Leroy Grant is born in New Harmony, Washington Co., Utah.

1886, May 21 – Grandson Francis Homer born in Trenton, Cache Co., Utah.

1887, Mar 21 – Granddaughter Eleanor Grant is born in New Harmony, Washington Co., Utah.

1888, Sep 19 – Grandson Robert Earl Homer is born in Trenton, Cache Co., Utah.

1889, Jan 14 – Granddaughter Emily Adelia Grant is born in New Harmony, Washington Co., Utah.

1889, Jun 22 – George Roberts Grant dies in Rocklin, Placier Co., California he is buried in the Rocklin Cemetery.

1889, Oct 6 – Grandson Robert Earl Homer dies in Trenton, Cache Co., Utah.

1890, Jul 10 – Grandson James Edgar Homer is born in Trenton, Cache Co., Utah.

1890, Nov 2 – Daughter Eleanor Roberta Petty marries James McDonald Hamilton in Pioche, Lincoln Co., Nevada.

1891, Feb 17 – Grandson George Albert Grant is born in New Harmony, Washington Co., Utah.

1892, Feb 20 – Death of husband William Warren Taylor who died tragically in New Harmony, Washington Co., Utah when a cellar caved in on him. He is buried in the New Harmony Cemetery, Washington Co., Utah.

1892, Aug 4 – Granddaughter Rosett Homer is born in Trenton, Cache Co., Utah.

1892, Sep 10 – Granddaughter Rosett Homer dies in Trenton and is buried in the Clarkston Cemetery in Cache Co., Utah.

1893, Jan 11 – Grandson Robert McDonald Hamilton is born in Trenton, Cache Co., Utah.

1893, Jan 17 - Granddaughter Pansey Grant is born in New Harmony, Washington Co., Utah.

1894, Jan 31 – Grandson Joseph Petty Homer is born in Trenton, Cache Co., Utah.

1894, Jul 9 – Granddaughter Mary Roberta Sawyer marries William Albert Adair in St. George, Washington Co., Utah.

1895, Aug 1 – Great grandson William Kenneth Adair is born in New Harmony, Washington Co., Utah.

1895, Sep 11 – Granddaughter Carrie Lavinnie McDonald Hamilton dies.

1895, Dec 15 – Grandson Floyd Grant is born in New Harmony, Washington Co., Utah.

1896, Oct 26 – Granddaughter Adelia Francesca Sawyer marries George Newton Adair in Beaver, Beaver Co., Utah.

1896, Jan 17 – Great grandson Thomas Ray Raymond is born to Eugenia Dorleski Sawyer, this child is born from the conception of his mother Eugenia to her father Joseph Winkle Sawyer. Thomas is born in Hatch, Garfield Co., Utah.

1900, Nov 28 – Grandson William Harrison Homer marries Ellen Grace Harper in Logan, Cache Co., Utah.

1900, Nov 30 – Grandson Rulon Lewis Taylor is born in New Harmony, Washington Co., Utah.

1901, Apr 6 – Granddaughter Beatrice Gertrude Taylor is born in New Harmony, Washington Co., Utah.

1901, Oct 7 – Great grandson Harold William Homer is born in Smithfield, Cache Co., Utah.

1901, Oct 24 – Great grandson Charles Albert Homer is born in Parker, Fremont Co., Idaho.

1902, May 25 – Sister-in-law Sarah Jane Miller Carbine dies.
