
Appendix

In the fall of 1833, two preachers of the Church of Latter Day Saints came to Greenwood from Geneseo, Livingston Co. N.Y. and preached a few sermons, and invited father and his brother-in-law, Josiah Richardson, and others, to make them a visit at Geneseo, where there was a large branch of the church. Accordingly father and three others went in Nov. and after investigating the doctrine taught, father became convinced, and was baptized into the church. In the latter part of 1834 and during 1835, several of the Elders of the Latter Day Saints visited Greenwood, and quite a number believed and joined the church. Among these were two of my sisters. A branch of the church was organized, and father was appointed to preside over it. (He had ~~been~~ previously been ordained an elder.)

In the spring of 1836 nearly all the members of this branch moved to Kirtland, Ohio, and some continued their journey to Caldwell Co. Mo. On October 7<sup>th</sup> 1837, my father with his family, which then consisted of my mother, two of my sisters and myself, started from Greenwood on a journey to Geauga Co. Ohio. My brother David and his wife and two children, and Mr. Ferguson my brother-in-law, his wife and two children, also went with us. They did not belong to the Church of Latter Day Saints. In May 1838 my father and two sisters and myself started for Caldwell Co. Mo., where we arrived the last day of Aug. 1838. We were just in time to pass through the persecution by the Missourians against the "Mormons". We left Caldwell Co. the first of Apr. 1839 for Illinois and located twelve miles east of Quincy Adams Co.

In the spring of 1838, my brother David moved to Michigan, and mother, having two brothers living there, desiring to make them a visit, went with him, intending to live with him until we got settled in the West. My brother George was then living in Ypsilanti Mich. In the summer of 1840, father went to Michigan and brought mother to Ill. In the spring








