WINIFRED H. SCHEIB

April 29, 1916 - May 17, 2016

Winifred Harris Scheib, a former resident of St. George and Hurricane, Utah died May 17, 2016 in Surprise, Arizona. She was born April 29, 1916 in Sioux Falls, South Dakota and recently celebrated her 100th birthday with friends and family in Arizona.

Winifred grew up in the Midwest, graduating from Park University in Parkville, Missouri. She worked several years in Kansas City, married Harold A. (Hal) Scheib and settled in Southern California where Hal was in the motion picture business. Wini worked part time in the family businesses, Cinema Research and Research Products of Hollywood. She was also a free lance writer with stories and articles published in numerous national magazines.

Upon Hal's retirement they moved to Hurricane in 1977 and then to St. George, where he died in 1986. She was a member of the Washington County Historical Society, the St. George Art Museum, the Celebrity Series, the Bloomington Literary Club and the Good Shepherd Presbyterian Church. She was an avid bridge player and collector of souvenir spoons. In later years she lived at The Meadows in St. George and Brookdale in Peoria, Arizona. At the end of her life she was looking forward to her final journey to the everlasting kingdom of her Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

She was preceded in death by her parents, two brothers, a sister and her daughter Patti. She is survived by her daughters Betsy (Allen) Crosson of Goodyear, Arizona and Carolyn (Robert) Barnett of Alta Loma, California. Surviving grandchildren are Eric (Aimee) Crosson, Timothy (Sarah) Crosson, Matthew, Lauren and Jessica Barnett and Laura (Chet) Hewitt. She has four great-grandsons and four great-granddaughters along with many nieces, nephews and friends. She will be interred in St. George alongside her husband.
